0. What's your name?

Here's a loop:

```
long int n;  
  
n = 2;  
printf("Powers of 2 up to 1,000,000.\n");  
while (n < 1000000) {  
    printf("%ld\n", n);  
    n *= 2;  
}
```

It prints out all the powers of 2 between 2 and 1,000,000.

1. Write an equivalent loop using `do-while` instead of `while`.

2. Write an equivalent loop using `for` instead of `while`.

3. Which of the three loop constructs do you think is best for this example?
Why?
